COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT NO. 1 OF 2010

17 AUGUST 2010

ESTABLISHING PARITY OF SALARIES OF LECTURING STAFF AND OFFICE-BASED LECTURERS EMPLOYED IN THE PUBLIC FURTHER EDUCATION AND TRAINING COLLEGES WITH SALARIES OF EDUCATORS IN PUBLIC BASIC EDUCATION

FURTHER EDUCATION AND TRAINING BARGAINING UNIT COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT NO 1 OF 2010

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1. PURPOSE OF THIS AGREEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to establish parity between the salaries of lecturing staff and office-based lecturers employed at Public Further Education and Training Colleges (FETC) with those of educators employed in public basic education.

2. SCOPE OF THIS AGREEMENT

This agreement applies to and binds:

- 2.1 The FET Colleges represented by the FETCEO as the employer;
- 2.2 All the lecturing staff as defined in the Further Education and Training Act as amended in 2006, whether such employees are members of trade union parties to this agreement or not;
- 2.3 All lecturers previously employed in terms of the Employment of Educators Act and transferred to the employ of colleges on 1 January 2008 as "office-based lecturers" (lecturers with no contact time) whether such employees are members of trade union parties to this agreement or not;
- 2.4 All office-based lecturers (lecturers with no contact time), appointed and remunerated by colleges and utilized in the same way as transferred lecturers referred to in paragraph 2.3 above, whether such employees are members of trade union parties to this agreement or not.

3. THE PARTIES TO COUNCIL NOTE AS FOLLOWS:

3.1 Before the implementation of ELRC Collective Agreement 1 of 2008: Framework for the establishment of an Occupation Specific Dispensation (OSD) for educators in public education,

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- all educators (including college-based lecturers) were on the same salary structure.
- 3.2 FET College lecturing staff/office-based lecturers were excluded from ELRC Collective Agreement 1 of 2008, which resulted in them not being on the same salaries as educators in public schools.
- 3.3 Collective Agreement 4 of 2009: Finalization of matters linked to the Occupational Specific Dispensation in Education, also did not apply to FET College lecturing staff/office-based lecturers, thus further widening the gap in salaries between educators in public schools and FET College lecturing staff/office-based lecturers.
- 3.4 The implementation of FETC Bargaining Unit Collective Agreement 1 of 2009: Implementation of an interim measure for lecturers who are employed in public further education and training colleges (FETC), provided only for a once-off cash interim relief payment. This did not change the salary position of the lecturing staff/office-based lecturers and, therefore, did not address the salary disparities caused by their omission from ELRC Collective Agreements 1 of 2008 and 4 of 2009.
- 3.5 FETC Bargaining Unit Collective Agreement 1 of 2009 reflected consensus that there is a need to address the disparities and establish new measures relating to the salary dispensation for FETC lecturing staff teaching/office-based lecturers in public colleges.
- 3.6 The FETC Sector is viewed as the training ground for vocational skills, which is much needed for the Country.
- 3.7 There are different categories of lecturing staff/office-based lecturers employed by colleges:
 - Former state-employed lecturing staff/office-based lecturers who transferred on 1 January 2008 to the employ of colleges and who are being remunerated via the Persal system;
 - Lecturing staff/office-based lecturers who, after 1 January 2008, were appointed by colleges and who are being remunerated via the Persal system;
 - Lecturing staff/office-based lecturers, who are being remunerated by colleges and who are not necessarily on the same salary notches as lecturing staff/office-based lecturers remunerated via the Persal system. These lecturing staff members/office-based lecturers are not eligible for the same benefits as lecturers who are being remunerated via the Persal system.



- 3.8 Persons appointed to management posts created in terms of the Public Service Act are excluded from the provisions of this Agreement as they are employees of the State.
- 3.9 Support staff are excluded from the provisions of this Agreement as they will be dealt with in the central bargaining processes of the GPSSBC.

4. THE PARTIES TO COUNCIL THEREFORE AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

4.1 No legitimately appointed lecturing staff member/office-based lecturer shall receive a basic salary that is less than what he/she received on 31 March 2010.

4.2 Salary structure

- 4.2.1 A salary structure, based broadly on the principles of ELRC Collective Agreement 1 of 2008, shall be implemented until such time that a new salary structure and conditions of service appropriate to public FETC lecturers have been developed.
- 4.2.2 The salary structure shall consist of a single salary scale with 221 notches, each 1% apart. The salary scale shall be the same as the OSD salary scale applicable to educators.
- 4.2.3 The following salary ranges shall be applicable to lecturing staff/office-based lecturers: (A salary range refers to the minimum and maximum notches applicable to a specific post.)

(Please note that, in terms of ELRC Collective Agreement 4 of 2003, job titles may differ from college to college.)

4.2.4 The same salary measures applicable to educators with regard to promotion, recognition of previous experience, determination of salary after a break in service, acting allowance, recognition of improvement of qualifications etc. shall be applicable until a new salary structure has been developed.

4.3 Implementation measures

The relevant provisions of ELRC Collective Agreements 1 of 2008 and 4 of 2009 shall apply as follows to

4.3.1 Category 1 lecturers (former state-employed lecturing staff/office-based lecturers who were transferred to the employ of colleges on 1 January 2008, as well as legitimately employed lecturina staff/office-based lecturers appointed after January 2008 and who are remunerated via the Persal

Step 1: Translation of salaries based on the principles contained in ELRC Collective Agreement 1 of 2008

system)

(a) Translate the lecturing staff member's/ office-based lecturer's July 2007 annual salary to the January 2008 OSD salary notch by using the same translation tables in terms of which educators' salaries were translated on 1 January 2008. Refer to Annexure A for the translation tables.

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(b) Translate January 2008 OSD annual salary to July 2009 OSD annual salary (cost-of-living increases). The lecturing staff member/office-based lecturer remains on the same notch. Refer to Annexure A.

Step 2: Salary progression (ELRC Collective Agreement 4 of 2009):

(a) Add 3 notches to the identified salary notch; provided that, on 31 March 2010. the lecturing staff member/office-based lecturer has been employed for at least 12 months (continuously) by the college (i.e. the lecturing staff member/officebased lecturer must have been employed by the college on or prior to 1 April 2009).

Step 3: Recognition of experience:

- (a) Only continuous (uninterrupted) service in the employ of the college or the state and the college, as on 31 March 2010, is taken into account.
- (b) One additional notch for every completed 36 months of service is added to the notch determined in Step 2 above.

4.3.2 Category 2 lecturers

(legitimately employed Lecturina staff/office-based lecturers remunerated colleges and who are on the same salary notches transferred lecturing staff/office-based lecturers or fall within the applicable salary ranges (i.e. colleges applied/apply the provisions of ELRC Collective Agreements 4 of 2003 and 5 of 2006).

4.3.2.1 The same salary measures as stipulated in paragraph 4.3.1 shall apply.

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4.3.3 Category 3 lecturers

(lecturers are earning less than the minimum salary notch as determined by ELRC Collective Agreement 4 of 2003)

Step 1(a): Translate the lecturing staff member's/office-based lecturer's July 2007 annual salary to the minimum applicable salary notch as indicated in paragraph 4.2.3.

Step 1(b): Translate the above salary notch to the July 2009 annual salary (cost-of-living increases) applicable to educators. The lecturing staff member/ office-based lecturer remains on the same notch. Refer to Annexure A.

Step 2: Salary progression (ELRC Collective Agreement 4 of 2009):

(a) Add 3 notches to the identified salary notch; provided that, on 31 March 2010. the lecturing staff member/office-based lecturer has been employed for at least 12 months (continuously) by the college (i.e. the lecturing staff member/officebased lecturer must have been employed by the college on or prior to 1 April 2009).

Step 3: Recognition of experience:

- (a) Only continuous (uninterrupted) service in the employ of the college or the state and the college, as on 31 March 2010, is taken into account.
- (b) One additional notch for every completed 36 months of service is added to the notch determined in Step 2 above.
- 4.3.4 The same principles applied in Steps 2 and 3 shall apply to a lecturing staff member/office-based lecturer legitimately appointed after 1 January 2008.

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4.4 Pay Progression

4.4.1 A 1% annual pay progression shall be paid with effect from the 1st of July 2010.

5. DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION

5.1 This agreement shall be implemented on the day of ratification and shall be backdated to the 1st April 2010.

6. INTERPRETATION AND APPLICATION

- 6.1. In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this Agreement and any other Agreement of the Council, the provisions of this Agreement shall take precedence.
- 6.2. No amendments to this Agreement shall be of force or effect unless reduced to writing and agreed upon by the parties to the Council as a Resolution of Council.

7. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

7.1 Any dispute about the interpretation or application of this agreement shall be resolved in terms of the dispute resolution procedure of the Council.

8. **DEFINITIONS**

- 8.1 "Council" means the Education Labour Relations Council.
- 8.2 "lecturing staff" means staff employed to perform a teaching function.
- 8.3 "**employer**" means the employer as defined in the FETC Act, 2006, as amended.
- 8.4 "legitimately employed" means employment duly authorize by the Council or its delegate onto a post on the approved organizational structure of the College.
- 8.5 "basic salary" means annual salary (notch) excluding benefits of a monetary nature such as medical aid subsidy, service bonus and housing allowance or any other allowance.
