- (b) That the amount of funding agreed to is R 0.40 (forty cents) per educator on a monthly basis and
- (c) That SACE is now receiving its own funding by means of statutory levies collected, monthly, from the salaries of educators.
- (d) That SACE has consented to supply Council, by December 31 2000, with audited financial statements accounting for the utilisation of all funds disbursed to it.

4. That the present statutory levy deducted from the monthly salaries of educators shall not be amended.



