1. INTRODUCTION

The ELRC is a bargaining Council established in terms of Section 37 (2) of the Labour Relations Act (LRA). The Council serves educators in the public education sector, specifically those employed in terms of the employment of Educators Act 76 of 1998. The Council also serves the learners of this country by effectively resolving disputes in the public education that involve the child as the victim or witness and therefore comply with section 28 of the Constitution of the South Africa which provides that the child's rights are of paramount importance in every matter concerning a child.

The Council has its Head Office in Centurion and has Provincial Chambers in all nine provinces of the country. The Council is looking to appoint a suitable service provider to insure all its assets including the head office building situated at 261 West Avenue, Centurion. 2. INVITATION TO TENDER

The ELRC is inviting reputable and experienced Insurance Broker/s or service providers to submit their proposals for provision of short- term insurance for a period of (36) Thirty-Six Months.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The successful bidder shall facilitate or provide insurance for all assets of the ELRC, including new assets. Ensure that all claims are attended to accordingly and that assets are correctly and comprehensively covered.

Ad-hoc adjustments and endorsements on sums insured and declaration to insurers/re-insurers.

Provide comprehensive insurance cover for losses which may be incurred due to:

- 3.1.1 Property Theft and Vandalism
- 3.1.2 Accidental Damages
- 3.1.3 Damage by natural causes that may result in loss of assets
- 3.1.4 Fire
- 3.1.5 Public Liability
- 3.1.6 Comprehensive Vehicle cover including roadside assistance

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3.1.7 All Business Risks

3.2 Facilitate Claim Submission and Administration.

3.3 Provide Other Administrative Services

NB: The above list serves as the guideline for requirements. Service providers must outline their service offering and claim processing procedures, turnaround time of finalizing claims as well as systems if available.

4.2 No submissions sent by e-mail or facsimile will be accepted, and no late submissions will be accepted.

4.3 Bidders are requested to submit five submissions marked "Technical and Financial Proposal" (one original and four copies).

4.4 Bidders should ensure that Bids are delivered on time to the correct address. If the bid is late, it shall not be accepted for consideration. The ELRC reception is generally accessible 7 hours a day (08h00 to 15h00); 5 days a week (Monday to Friday).

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4.5 Bidders must ensure that they sign the register at the reception when delivering Bids. Bidders must advise their couriers of the instruction above to avoid misplacement of bid responses.

ALL BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON THE OFFICIAL FORMS – (NOT TO BE RE-TYPED).

4.6 One hardcopy must be the original submission, clearly marked "Original" and the remaining be copied versions of the original. (Also see 4.3 above)

4.6 Service providers should take particular care to ensure that there are no discrepancies on hardcopy submissions of the proposed solution.

4.7 Responses to this RFP must follow a two-envelope approach where service providers' pricing and technical response must be submitted in separate sealed envelopes. The copies must be bundled together and submitted as a single pack and clearly marked indicating the contents of the envelope as well as the BID number and the Details on the bidder be clearly indicated on the documents.

4.7.1 Each individual envelope must be clearly marked with the following information:

Name of the RFP,

RFP Number

ORIGINAL or COPY 1 or COPY 2 etc.

Return address label indicating the name and address of the Service Provider.

5. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

5.1 Bidders must meet all mandatory requirements as stipulated in the tender document. Failure to comply with any of the requirements leads to the bidder being disqualified.

5.2 The mandatory requirements below are not subjected to any scoring as these are absolute minimum requirements.

The bidders shall be obliged to submit the following:

5.2.1 One original tender (signed)

5.2.2 Valid Tax Compliance Pin

5.2.3 Recently Audited Annual financial statements with signed audit report in case of a company.

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- 5.2.4 Original Certified copies (Copy with original stamp) of your CIPRO company registration documents listing all members with percentages, in case of a CC.
- 5.2.5 Latest Original Certified copies of all share certificates (i.e., copy with original stamp), in case of a company.
- 5.2.6 Submission of ID copy for the Company Representative
- 5.2.7 Proof of agreement from the Insurance underwriter
- 5.2.8 Indemnity Cover with minimum R2 million cover.
- 5.2.9 Standard Bidding Documents – completed and signed.
- 5.2.10 Proof of Registration with Financial Services Conduct Authority (FSCA)
- 5.2.11 NB: 5.2.8 applies to both organisation and the assigned accounts manager.

6. SECURITY CLEARANCE OF BIDDERS

- a) The ELRC may conduct all relevant security checks on the prospective provider prior to the awarding of the contract. Supplier information and good standing will also be verified with National Treasury database to determine whether the bidder is not listed on the restricted Suppliers for tender defaulters.

7. EVALUATION

- 7.1 Proposals will be evaluated in terms of the prevailing Supply Chain Policy applicable to the ELRC and it should be noted that:

Phase 1: Initial Screening Process: During this phase, bid responses will be reviewed for compliance with RFP requirements including the general bid conditions, which requirements include the following:

- Submission of a valid Tax Compliance Pin
- Submission of Company Registration Forms -CIPC
- Submission of ID copy for the Company Representative
- Completion of all Standard Bidding Documents and other requirements, as reflected in this RFP.
- All requirements indicated under paragraph 5 above. (Mandatory requirements)

Phase 2: Technical/ Functionality Evaluation Bid responses will be evaluated in accordance with the Functional criteria as follows:

- The functionality of the service provider will be demonstrated by the soundness of the proposal received.

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- Each component outlined will be scored and weighted according to the prescribed process
- Services providers that will be shortlisted for the Pricing Evaluation phase will be those who have achieved a **minimum score of 65% of the total score 100.**

Phase 3: All bids that met the minimum criteria will be evaluated on the **80/20-point scoring basis.**

- a) The **80** points will be for Price and **20** points are for Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (BBBEE) for attaining the BBBEE Status.
- b) Submit VALID Original Affidavit or **Certified copies** of BBBEE certificate
